# 2015 Creyssels, Languedoc, Picpoul de Pinet

Very open citrus, nettle and herbal aromas, with rich texture and the expected stony finish. As appealing as an aperitif as with all types of seafood

#### Domaine du Tariquet, Classic, IGP Cotes de Gascone, 2015

Scent of fresh cut fruit, mildly tropical; and entirely consistent with the zesty palate, citrus flavoured with notes of passion-fruit and pineapple

#### Champagne & Prosecco

#### Lunetta, Prosecco Spumante, 20 cl Bottle

Aromas of stone fuits, particularly peach, and also hints of apple. A crisp, light, and well-balanced wine with creamy mousse and delicate apple and pear characters

#### Lunetta, Rosé Spumante, 20 cl Bottle

Pale salmon with fine and a persistent white froth. The bouquet shows fragrant, with enticing aromas of small red berries. The palate is clean, fresh and fruity.

### Drusian, Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Extra Dry, Veneto, Italy

Deliciously sherbety, light, and with the merest hint of fruity sweetness, one can consume this charming example with alarming ease

### Thomas-Hatté, Tradition Brut, NV

His 'Tradition' blend is produced from 70% Pinot Meunier, 20% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Noir. With a fine mousse and attractive piercing citrus and green apple aromas, this shows a surprising level of maturity for a non-vintage champagne, thanks to the high proportion of Pinot Meunier.

## 2014 Comtesse de Marion, Merlot, IGP Pays d'Oc

The Vic family's Merlot has won huge praise and many repeat orders from satisfied customers. It's a wine which always shows attractive typicity: aromas of sweet plum with a leafy touch, followed by a supple and lightly creamy, berried palate with barely discernible tannins.

### Cháteau La Plaige, Bordeaux Superieur, 2012

£18.00

From from Frédéric Naud, a fifth generation vigneron, a blend of 40% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25% Cabernet Franc. Friendly raspberry nose. Supple, aromatic, red fruited with a proper claret structure.

## Les Vignerons d'Estezargues, Cotes du Rhone, Terra Vitis, 2015

£18.00

Terra Vitis is a sustainable, minimal intervention farming discipline, half way to organic viticulture, practiced by five members of this small co-operative. As opposed to the Galets this has Carignan and Mourvèdre in the blend too, so is more black-fruited, and has a little more stuffing.
